



Readiness Skills

- ELA (Writing & Reading)
 - Align English 12 with college credit writing course (ENGL101/102)
 - *Potential:* Align English with developmental writing and reading
- Math
 - Align with college credit math (MATH132/135 (College Algebra & Trig/Precalculus), MATH200 (Statistics), MATH201/202 (Calculus))
 - *Potential:* Senior year math elective that reviews and builds upon basic math skills (arithmetic, elementary and intermediate algebra) and statistical literacy
- College Success
 - Offer standalone or integrated success courses (ACAD100 or ACAD150)
- Financial literacy
 - Offer as a senior year elective, embedded within economics, or within Career & Financial Management (BUAD109)

Enrichment

- Online courses through TC3 – in the liberal arts or career interest areas
- Expanded access to concurrent enrollment
- Taking courses campus – students now work with CollegeNow office
- Early degree – CEP and online course taking aligned with specific degree paths

Assessment

- Academic skills
 - Diagnostic or placement testing followed by targeted advisement, courses, and AIS
 - Test prep in spring of senior year
