ADEQUACY AND SUFFICIENCY OF RESEARCH</b>  <i>The researcher's investigation follows the Research Frame and the information gathered is sufficient.</i>	<b>Adequacy of the research:</b> The researcher's investigation is based on the Research Frame and the claims and information presented link directly to the Inquiry Paths.		
	<b>Sufficiency of the answers:</b> The answers formulated by the researcher based on his/her investigation are sufficient to cover the scope of each Inquiry Path.		
	<b>Adequacy of the scope and focus of the research:</b> No Inquiry Questions or Paths of the research seem irrelevant with respect to the Research Frame.		
<b>II. CREDIBILITY AND RICHNESS OF SOURCES</b>  <i>The sources gathered by the researcher are credible and rich.</i>	<b>Credibility of sources :</b> The sources gathered by the researcher are credible.		
	<b>Richness of sources:</b> The researcher found a reasonable amount of rich sources that provide important information that is relevant to the inquiry.		
<b>III. RANGE OF PERSPECTIVES</b>  <i>The researcher has considered a wide range of perspectives.</i>	<b>Richness of perspectives:</b> The researcher has considered and explored multiple perspectives.		
	<b>Sufficiency of perspectives:</b> No important perspective has been ignored.		
	<b>Balance among perspectives:</b> There is no over reliance on any one source or perspective.		
<b>IV. ACCURACY OF THE PERSPECTIVE</b>  <i>The EBCs drawn from the analysis of the sources are coherent, sound and supported.</i>	<b>Coherence of EBCs:</b> The evidence-based claims drawn from the analysis of the sources are coherent with respect to the Research Frame.		
	<b>Soundness of EBCs:</b> The evidence-based claim demonstrates knowledge of and sound thinking about the Area of Investigation.		
	<b>Support for EBCs :</b> The evidence-based claims are supported by quotations and examples from the texts.
