- 4. Assist in development & implementation of public timetables, maps & other informational items.
- 5. Assist in development & implementation of transportation services for special events, contract services, and subcontract charts as needed. Interacts with clients and client agencies to set service parameters and provide costing estimates.
- 6. Provides technical support on Intelligent Transportation Systems projects including, but not limited to: Automated Vehicle Locators, Automated Passenger Counters, Automated Transit Itinerary Planning, Automated Fare Collection, Interactive Kiosks and Vehicles Surveillance Systems.
- 7. Assist department staff with schedule storage and maintaining accurate schedule inventories
- 8. Formulates and implements data collection activities to support departmental reporting requirements.
- 9. Investigates and responds to service complaints and coordinates resolutions with other departments.
